MISSION

This Is ME fosters substance in the world of adolescent and teen girls through programs designed for the “whole girl.” With the guidance of exceptional women, girls have the opportunity to explore their individual strengths and learn to sustain positive relationships in a supportive, creative, and open environment.

This Is ME has served more than 660 girls since offering our first program at the Irving Park YMCA in January of 2000. We currently partner with Reinberg School, the Logan Square Library, Our Lady of Grace School (also in Logan Square), the Junior League of Chicago, Metropolitan Family Services, and Saint Andrew School to deliver a variety of programs, including: a monthly drop-in program, weekly after-school programs, and bi-annual 6-week workshops.

This is ME is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization.

PROGRAMMING OBJECTIVES

Provide enriching opportunities to help girls grow in self-awareness and adopt positive values.

Involve girls in planning, evaluating and leading activities.

Maintain an environment that is: safe from external threats, a group made up of only female participants who are open and sincere to one another, run by leaders who offer balanced guidance and friendship and that allows each girl to recognize, celebrate and enhance her capacity to achieve.

Provide girls with opportunity to develop into leaders both now and in the future.

Surround girls with positive images of females so that they see the various ways that women better the world and are inspired to affect the world in their own ways.

Offer girls activities that foster their drive to achieve, persist, gain resilience and a sense of accomplishment.
